**1. Apologies & Acceptance of reason for Absence**

**2. Declarations of Interest**

There were no member's declarations of interest.

**4. Deputy Chair**

Cllr Ruston was elected Deputy Chair of Planning Committee for 2021/22.

**4. Minutes of last Meeting**

The minutes of the Planning Committee held on 14<sup>th</sup> April 2021 were confirmed and signed as a true record. Proposed Cllr Ruston, seconded Cllr Corby (5 for, 1 abstention).

**5. Matters Arising**

There were no matters arising from the minutes of the meeting held 14<sup>th</sup> April 2021.

**6. Planning Applications**

Cllr Kidd advised HTC had responded to all current planning applications.

12 Princess Drive planning application had come up again under permitted development and application likely to go through if there are no objections from neighbours.

Cllr Kidd gave a detailed report on the arrival of a large Ferris Wheel on the Kit Kat site and advised he had spoken to the BCKLWN Planning Enforcement Officer responsible for action against unauthorised activities.

There is nothing the Enforcement Officer can do at this stage as it is permitted under emergency Government Covid legislation relaxing the normal rules and allowing 56 days occupancy which starts from 9th June.

However, rules on noise, pollution, disturbance and overlooking etc. still apply and may give them a route for enforcement.

The situation will be monitored and action taken where possible.
